The requirement for the necessary experience of the different methods and levels are listed in the following table:

Method	Experience in month		
	Level 1	Level 2	Level 3
VT	1	3	24
RT	3	9	36
UT	3	9	36
MT	1	3	24
PT	1	3	24
ET	3	9	36

It is important to keep track of all the methods the candidate has worked with since it is possible to get a "discount" on the experience of time if the candidate works with several methods. By two methods you get 25% discount at 3 methods 33% discount, and by 4 or more methods 50% discount.

For Level 2 the required experience is equal to the sum of Level1 and Level 2 and, similarly to Level 3, this gives e.g. that a

- Level 2 Certificate of PT requires $(1+3=)$ 4 months of experience.
- Level 2 Certificate in both MT and PT is required $4 + 4$ months $\div 25\% = 6$ months' experience in total.
- Level 2 Certificate of MT, PT, UT required $4 + 4 + 12$ months $\div 33\% = 13.5$ months' experience.

If you work overtime this can be accepted in the calculated experience against documentation. The certificate can not be issued/dated prior experience is earned.
